SHIPWRECKS ABOVE WATER • SHIPWRECKS UNDERWATER WITH DIVERS • SHIPWRECKS & NATURE

To qualify for the Major, 'Best in Show' prize, the school, amateur or professional entrant must submit images in at least two of the above categories in their division.
