



Internet web site policy

- 1/ The web site will be maintained by a person appointed by the Federal Secretary with approval from the Federal Board from time to time.
- 2/ All web site access passwords will held by the person nominated, the Federal Secretary and Federal President.
- 3/ All changes and maintenance of the web site will be preformed by the person appointed by the Federal Secretary, Unless circumstances dictate otherwise and then the federal secretary or federal president will carry out the changes needed
- 4/ Web site design shall be approved by the Federal Secretary and Federal President
- 5/ The internet service provider (ISP) will be appointed from time to time as necessary with the approval of the Federal Board
- 6/ Use of the web services associated with the AUF web page should not be for unlawful or improper use nor breach any statutory laws or board policy relating to discrimination vilification or harassment.
- 7/ Web or network services should not be used to convey any messages or correspondence that may be considered defamatory or fraudulent.
- 8/ Reproduction of materials sourced via email or web browsing can be subject to copyright or licensing. If in doubt do not copy or forward any such information without appropriate permission.
- 9/ The web site is for the sole use of the AUF and shall not promote any business, goods or services unless agreed to by the Federal Board
- 10/ Access to web sites or discussion groups considered offensive or dangerous should not be attempted.
- 11/ The web site shall only be used to promote the aims and objectives of the Federation as set out in the Federal Constitution.
- 12/ All commission web sites state and Federal must comply with this policy
- 13/ All State and Federal commission web sites must be content approved and linked to the AUF site

14/ No advertising can be placed on any AUF Web site, State or Federal without the approval of the Federal President.
