ADDITIONAL EXPENSES:

Travel (including from/to airport/train station/swimming pool) and accommodation are not included in the entry fee.

All other costs are at the team's expense.

PLAYING SCHEDULE

Mixed Division will be 2 groups of 4 teams each.

Female Division will be double round robin with a final.

Refer to the attached playing schedule. In general games will be:

Group stages/Round Robin:

1. 2x10 minute halves running clock
2. 3 minute half time
3. 1 time out per team.

Playoffs/Finals

1. 2x15minute halves running clock
2. 5 minute half time
3. 1 TO per team

TEAM LIST:

The team list must include:

Team name: Club name, Mixed or Women Division

Players: Cap number, name, AUF membership and expiring date.

Team leader/coach: Name and function

Referee/Diving Certification or License number, if available.

THE DIVING POOL:

Playing area dimensions: Court 1/ 20 m. long, 12 m. wide and 5 m. depth.

Sleeman Sports Complex is located on the corner of Old Cleveland and Tilley Roads, approximately 15 kilometers east of the Brisbane CBD and 15 kilometers south of Brisbane Airport.

ACCOMMODATION:

Arranged by the teams themselves.

RULES:

The CMAS International UWR rules 2019 will be applied during the entire tournament.

REFEREES:

Each team has to provide two referees per game. The organizer will provide scuba tanks for one of the referees, CBD, regulator and weights. Current scuba diving license/certificate have to be submitted to organisers before the start of the tournament.

The second referee will use his own snorkeling gear. Protection suits against cold have to be organized by the referees themselves.

1. All referees must be ready before the scheduled start time of their match. If a referee is not ready when the teams are ready to start (6 players for each team ready in the water), its team will be penalized by -1 point.
2. Teams must be ready before the scheduled start time of their match. If a team is not ready when the referees and opposite team are ready to start (6 players ready in the water and three referees), this team will be penalized by -1 point.
3. All unsportsmanlike behaviour by individuals will be penalised by -1 point to the team that player/players belong. (Referees or Jury to determine the outcome)

JURY OF THE TOURNAMENT:

Per UWRA By Laws.

PROTEST:

Written protest must be turned in to the jury of the tournament by the team leader within 30 min after the game ends. Protest fee is \$70 AUD for each appeal. Jury determinations are final and incontestable. In the event that a protest is unsuccessful, the protest fee will not be refunded.

EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY:

Participants participate at their own risk. The organizers cannot be held liable for any personal injury or material damages.
